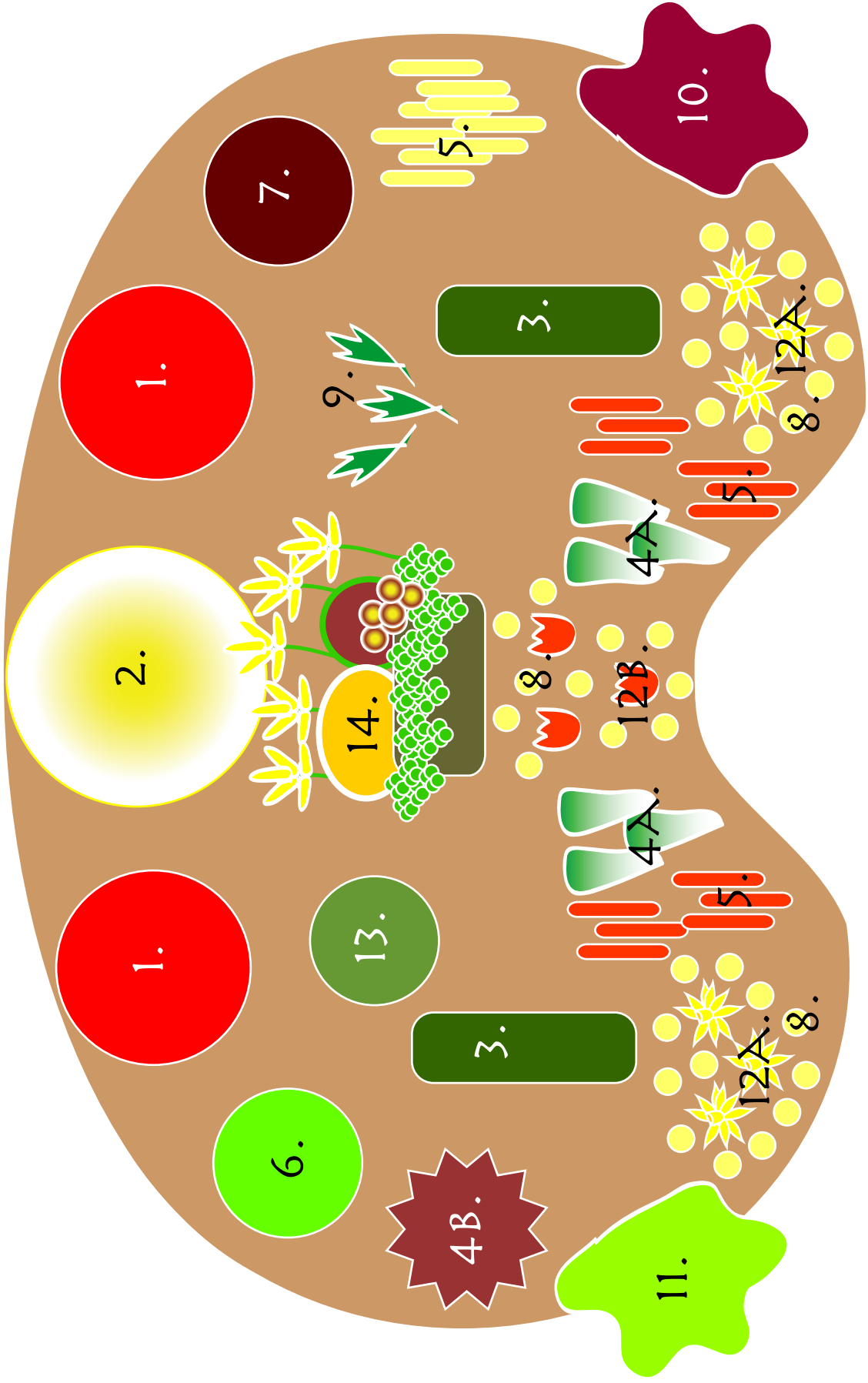


THEMED FALL GARDEN

This themed garden is approximately 3'-4' wide x 10' - 12' across.

It includes many different types of plants, including: evergreen, perennials, annuals and early spring bulbs, thus giving your garden color and interest all year long. The winter annuals can be replaced with summer annuals around mid April, though it should be noted that pansies usually thrive until it gets really hot. All plants in this garden need six to eight hours of morning sun.

1. RED KNOCK OUT ROSE – Deciduous shrub. Full to part sun. 4'x 4'. Red blooms from spring to fall. This brand is more resistant to bugs and disease than any other brand.
2. CAMELLIA SINENSIS – Evergreen shrub with white blooms in the fall. Eight feet mature height. Can be pruned. Leaves can be used to make green tea!
3. SKY PENCIL HOLLY – Evergreen shrub. Can grow 6' - 8' H, though can be pruned to desired size.
4. ORNAMENTAL VEGGIES – A. Pak Choi: Beautiful white stems with green leaves; 12" H; Yellow flower in spring. Cold weather brings out the colorful leaves. B. Redbor Kale: Colorful foliage which is enhanced with cold weather. Usually 12" - 18" H.
5. SNAPDRAGONS – Biennial; Exquisite blooms with many color choices. Flowers in both fall and spring. Ranges from 8" - 14" H. In this garden we have chosen Montego Yellow and Tahiti Scarlet. Full to part sun.
6. GREEN SPICE HEUCHERA – Evergreen plant that features a mounding growth habit. Many colors to choose from. Morning sun/afternoon shade
7. CHOCOLATE CHIP AJUGA – Evergreen ground cover that grows up to 6" H. Morning sun/afternoon shade.
8. VIOLAS & PANSIES – The only flower to bloom through the winter and into spring. If you are looking to add a splash of color, you definitely want this plant! Ranges from 6" - 8" H. Full to part sun. In this garden, we used Rocky Lemon Violas.
9. ACORUS GRASS (SWEET FLAG) – Evergreen grass that grows 10" - 14" H. Full to part sun.
10. DRAGONS BLOOD SEDUM – An evergreen trailing ground cover. Full sun.
11. LYSMACHIA (CREEPING JENNY) – Chartreuse trailing ground cover. Semi-evergreen/hardy perennial. Full to part sun.
12. TULIPS & DAFFODILS – Full sun. These bring life to your garden in early spring. A. Daffodils: In this garden we used Narcissus Tete-a-tetes that blooms yellow in early spring; 8" H; Full to part sun. We also used Narcissus Holland Sensation; Bloom time early spring; 20" H; White with yellow. B. Tulips: Red Riding Hood Tulips bloom mid-spring; 12" H.
13. ARP ROSEMARY – Aromatic evergreen herb used in sachets and cooking. Full sun. 4'x4'. Can be pruned.
14. CONTAINER – Green in front: Creeping Jenny #11, Gold circle: Mum/replace with Kale after first frost, Maroon/Gold circles: Delta Fire Pansy 8", Maroon circle: Dwarf Nandina Firepower full-part sun 1'-2' H x 2' W Red foliage in winter months followed by creamy white blooms in spring & red fruit in fall, Yellow flowers in back: Solidago (Goldenrod) Perennial with wispy yellow flowers in the fall. Full to part sun & 24" - 30" H.
